The Supervisors of Weisenberg Township, Lehigh County, PA held their advertised budget meeting at 5:00 pm at the Township office. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Linda Gorgas. Supervisors Anthony Werley & Richard Bleiler, Manager Brian Carl, Treasurer Jeff Strauss & Administrative Assistant Janet Henritz were also in attendance.

Proposed income & expenses for 2023 were discussed for preparation of the 2023 Township budget. An executive session will be held on 10/10 at 6 pm to discuss employee salaries for 2023. The next budget meeting will be on 11/7 at 5 pm.

The 2023 Employee Pension MMO, maintaining the rate of 12% was approved by motion of Anthony Werley, 2nd by Richard Bleiler. Vote 3-0 in favor.

Brian discussed the volume of administrative work for Weisenberg & Lowhill. The workload & responsibilities have been increasing steady over recent years in both Townships and things are getting more complex. Issues that previously took 1 hour now take 2-3 hours. Some Weisenberg items are being placed on the "back burner" in order to deal with Lowhill issues. The Board agreed and has questioned how much longer we would be able to provide services to Lowhill for the past few years.

Motion to approve Resolution 22-11 which discontinues Weisenberg Township office staff from performing Lowhill administrative & zoning services was made by Richard Bleiler, 2nd by Anthony Werley. Vote 3-0 in favor.

Weisenberg would like to maintain a positive relationship with Lowhill Township. Brian & Janet will work with the Lowhill staff in order to transition things over, ensure documents are transferred & provide training.

With no further business, Linda Gorgas adjourned the meeting at 7:50 pm.
