Outreach Program Process

Mr. Doyle and Ms. Smith presented a summary presentation of the public outreach results from the targeted planning workshop meetings with the following groups: Northern Lehigh School District, North Western School District, EMS Services, Infrastructure Experts, Lehigh County Officials, Local Municipal Officials and Small Businesses. Mr. Doyle stated that many of the meetings had reoccurring themes of the following:

- Local financial and safety burden created bypass-through traffic, both commuter and track
- Impacts from industrial/warehouse uses, particularly traffic
- Importance and increasing use of D&L Trail, particularly in Slatington
- Need to continue generating revenue without giving up rural and farming character
- Figure out how NL continues to fit into the larger fabric of the region while maintaining identity

Farmers Group Outreach Plan
